Job Description

The Peer Tutor position will focus on tutoring students in Studio courses specific to their major. Tutoring will focus primarily on the technical aspects of Studio courses, but may also include writing.

Responsibilities

- Tutor students one-on-one in Studio courses specific to their major
- Attend a Peer Tutoring training in the Fall semester
- Attend periodic check-in meetings with the Tutorial Coordinator and other Peer Tutors

And other duties as assigned by supervisor.

Qualifications

Ideal candidate will possess the following qualifications:

- At least one recommendation from a faculty member
- Have a GPA of 3.5 or above in their major
- Enjoy working with different types of people and different skill levels
- Demonstrate interest and enthusiasm for studio arts and learning
- Possess leadership potential and willingness to initiate projects

Other pertinent information about this position

Hours for this position may not be consistent, since they depend upon student demand and Peer Tutor availability.

Both work study and non-work study students may be peer tutors.
