



## **Financial Aid Code of Conduct**

Moore College does not have a preferred lender arrangement. The school will certify any loan from any lender selected by a borrower.

Moore College does not request or accept assistance with call center or financial aid staffing.

Moore College does not permit any officer, employee, or agent of the college to accept any gifts of greater than a nominal value from any lender, guarantor, or servicer.

Moore College financial aid staff does not participate in any activities, investment or financial relationships with lenders or financial aid-related entities.
